- Experience working in a day camp setting
- Awareness of risk management and best practices for child safety
- Strong leadership, administration and planning skills
- Interest in the recreation, education, social services or social science fields
- Ability to lead and facilitate age appropriate activities, games and discussions
- Ability to lead sports, crafts, games, arts, music and/or drama activities for 6-12yr old children, in an interactive, fun and high energy manner
- Must have a genuine interest in Children's Rights, inclusion and anti-racism
- Knowledge in the *Equitas* "Play it Fair" Toolkit is an asset
- Ability to work in a team setting
- The candidate must successfully pass a Police Record Check
- Valid First Aid & CPR certification, must obtain prior to employment confirmation
