The rink is open!

We're thrilled to welcome the community back to a revitalized rink featuring a brand-new ice surface and state-of-the-art ice plant that will last us for another 50 years! The building was ceremonially awakened on Monday, February 16, with a traditional welcome and words offered by representatives of Alec Dan from the Musqueam Nation and Wes Nahanee from the Squamish Nation. This meaningful ceremony brought life, spirit, and positive energy into a space that continues to be the heart of our neighbourhood. We extend our sincere thanks to the City of Vancouver facility team, planners, rink maintenance, management and City Council for their commitment to renewing this vital community hub.

We are home to a number of unique programs in the City including the Britannia Secondary Hockey Academy, the only VSB sports specific mini school, HEROS Hockey, empowering children on and off the ice, Canuck Autism Network, Women's Gender Diverse League and the largest open and accessible Vancouver Adult Co-ed Hockey League. The rink is open seven days a week for more than 7,000 hours annually. Beyond physical fitness, it supports mental well-being, teamwork, leadership, and lifelong learning.

Skating at Britannia is truly a sport for all ages and abilities. At Britannia skating is a lifelong sport for all ages and abilities, our organized sports leagues centre community development through teamwork, discipline, working together and perseverance. This rink is a social hub and gathering place that brings us together and strengthens our relationships, in the programming spaces we have food security and social services activities, arts, culture and Indigenous led programs all under one roof. If you have not skated or visited the rink in awhile consider going by for one of our free skates or just drop in to spend some time soaking in the buzz and scrape of skates, smell of the cold and the nostalgia of the hard wooden benches...some things we will never change!

Refund Policy

NEW

General programs:

- Full refunds given prior the start of the program.
- Requests on the day of the program (calculated as end of day) or after, a pro-rated refund will be given.
- Refund requests made beyond 48 hours prior to the scheduled third class, will not be accepted

For workshops & outings:

- A full refund will be granted if the refund is requested one week (seven days) prior to the start of the program. No refunds after this time.

For daycamps:

- A \$10 administration fee will be charged for each camp a refund is requested for. Refund requests must be made one week (seven days) prior to the start of the program. No refunds after this time.

Swim/Skate Refunds

- Full refund will be granted five days or more prior to the start of the program. Partial refunds granted within four days of program start or before the second class. Exceptions: No refunds on single session programs.
- Transfers possible prior to second class. No refunds after second class.

Cancellation Policy

- Courses are cancelled when too many people wait until the last minute to register. A minimum number must enrol before a class will run.
- Programs may be cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances and instructors may change during the program season.

Subsidy Policy

Britannia provides assistance to those who are not able to afford the advertised cost of certain programs and activities. Please note: Maximum of two subsidies per person per season. Some programs do not qualify for subsidy. Our subsidy policy does not apply to Britannia Child Care programs or products that are resalable.

Only residents of Vancouver are eligible for subsidies.

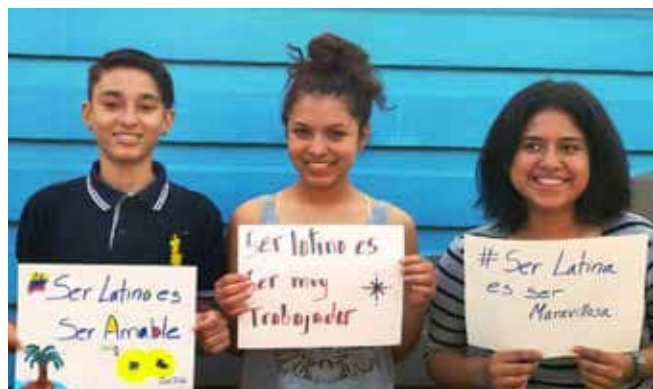

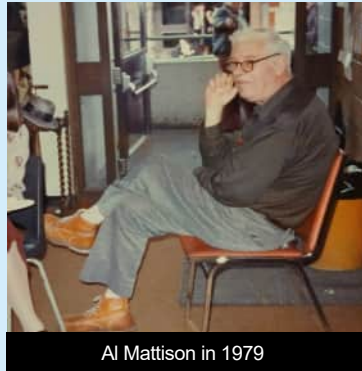
Remembering Al Mattison

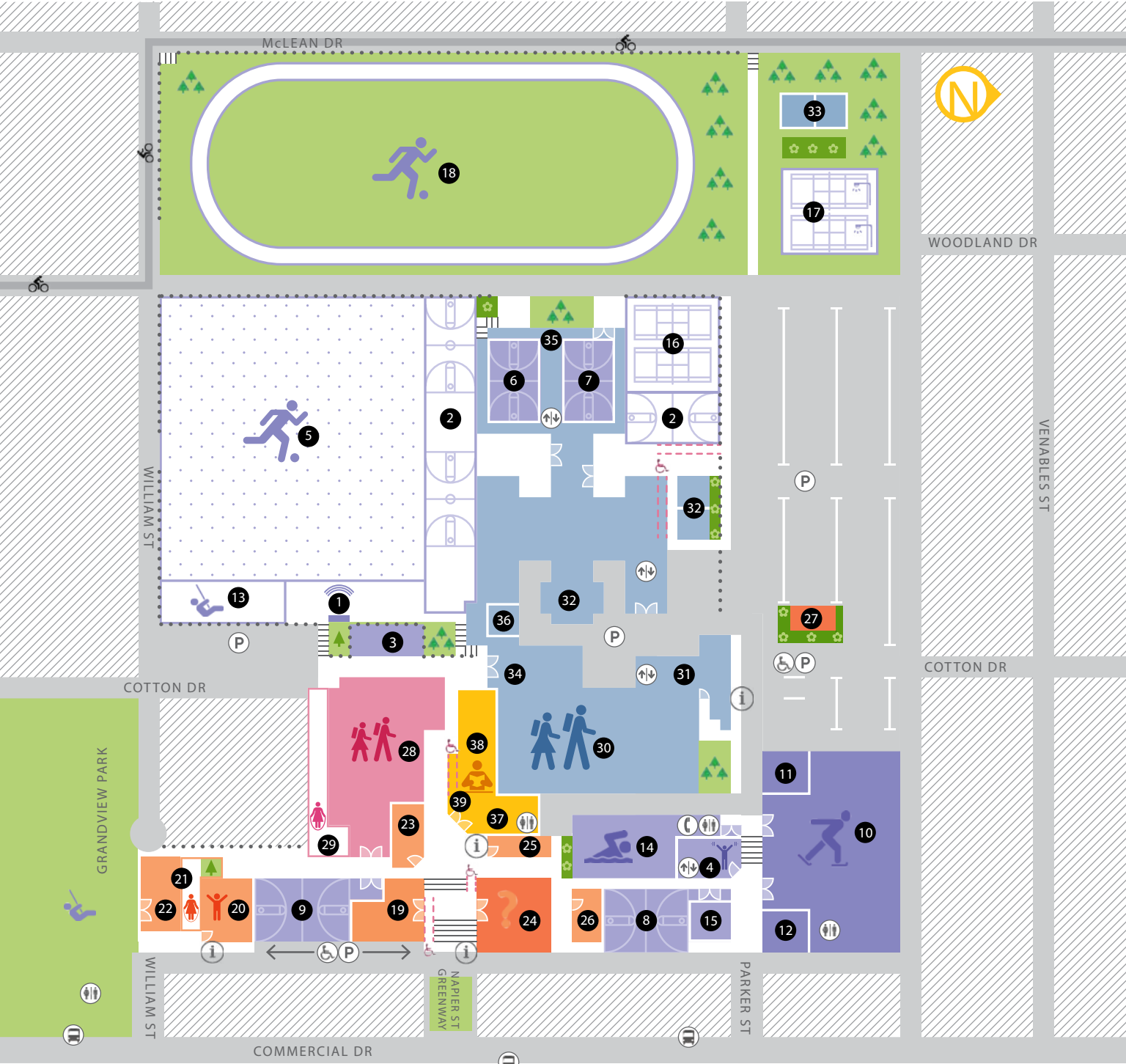
